The Emily Johnson "Play it Forward" Tournament and Scholarship was founded to honor a beautiful young woman who connected with the passion in her life and shared it with others.

The purpose of The Emily Johnson "Play it Forward" Scholarship is to annually award three scholarships to high school seniors to assist with the cost of attending a college or university.

The scholarship will be funded with an annual 3v3 soccer tournament and contributions from generous friends and businesses that will bring a community together to celebrate Emily's life.

ABOUT EMILY

Emily was a vivacious 16 year old young woman, with a magnetic personality that always attracted people to her and made each one feel special. She was beautiful, vibrant, and energetic. She loved her family and friends and never stopped letting them know. Emily was the captain and "heart" of her Coal Ridge High School soccer team. She was passionate about the game and her enthusiasm was contagious! She was extremely creative, especially with photography and film. Her crazy ideas were legendary, and she brought so much laughter, fun, and joy to everyone! Making a difference was so important to her. Since she was a little girl, she fought injustice and prejudice, rallied people to her causes, and after death, saved five lives and helped dozens more through the donation of her organs, corneas, bones and tissues. Emily lives on in them, and in the hearts of all of us who were so lucky to know and love her.



Creativity Scholarship

A \$4,000.00 non-renewable scholarship awarded to one recipient annually. This scholarship may be used at any college, university or vocational school. The scholarship will be paid directly to the Financial Aid Office of the selected college.

3.0 grade point average or above

Guidelines for Recommendation Letters:

You must submit two letters of recommendation with your application following the criteria below.

Letter may be written by: (select two categories from list)

1. Teacher
2. Leader in the community (principal, spiritual leader, counselor, board member, etc.)
3. Personal acquaintance who is NOT a family member (personal family friend over the age of 25)
4. Work reference from employer

Subject matter: (select either category from list)

1. How have you witnessed this individual improving the lives of their classmates, their teammates, their peers, their community, or the world?
2. Describe a specific instance in which the applicant exemplified the qualities of strength, dedication, and passion.

Guidelines for Essay:

You must submit an essay that is typed, double spaced, and at least 250 words but not more than 500. The essay needs to answer one or more of the questions listed below:

1. What is your passion?
2. How has your creative passion "played it forward" into the community?
3. How will you use your passion to make a difference in the world?

Example/Representation of Your Creative Passion:

You must submit an example (photograph, video, audio, physical project, etc.) of your creative passion with your application. There are no guidelines, so have fun and be as creative as possible!

Interviews with Top Five Applicants:

Applications will be reviewed and five candidates will be selected to interview with the scholarship committee for 15-30 minutes. At this time, interviewees will be asked interview questions and will present or perform their creative passion. Interviews will be set up individually with the selected candidates.

Award of Creativity Scholarship:

One candidate will be awarded the Creativity Scholarship and recognized at the Senior Banquet in May.
